## **Uniform Policy**

Language is core to Classical education. As a visual language, clothing reveals and communicates the heart at some level. Since we believe that classical Christian education is a gift from God that he uses to glorify man who in turn glorifies Him and one another, the message we wish to convey through our uniform is one of unity amidst diversity, modesty, discretion, order, reverence, and glory. Just as hair is for glory and not modesty, ties, pleats, collars, matching socks, and stockings are for glory. They are an adornment – a decoration. This glory, however, is not a self-directed glory, so bling that comes in the form of glitter headbands, large earrings and other piercings, snazzy socks, hot pink hair, etc. are not part of the uniform. As glory-seekers, we also value modesty and discretion, traits that stand the test of time. Classical Christian education is the great tradition passed down from generation to generation. This tradition includes cultural artifices such as clothing, so we should expect a classic school uniform to be reminiscent of those worn in previous generations, rather than unduly influenced by the latest fashion trends. Contemporary culture emphasizes personal comfort, individualized preferences, and expression of self. However, we wish to create and promote an environment of learning where dress is not a distraction from the educational process, but rather supports and enhances it.

Our development of a uniform policy is driven by a desire to create and promote an environment of learning where dress is not a distraction to the educational process. The motivation for the policy has grown out of the following principles:

- Our goal is to honor God in all we do, acknowledging the Lordship of Jesus Christ in our choices. All human actions, including outward manifestations such as clothing, reveal and communicate the disposition of the heart at some level. Through the uniform policy, we can proactively train the affections of students as they prepare for adulthood, rather than constantly reacting to personal choices of a multitude of students that may not be appropriate in the absence of such a policy.
- Clothing represents the vocational calling of a person, and inherent in the uniform policy is a desire to create an environment where undue attention is not drawn to specific students. The neat and coherent appearance created by a uniform enhances a ready-to-learn atmosphere.
- Uniforms help engender a cohesive presentation of the students in our school. When our students are in uniform it communicates, aesthetically, that they are part of the same team, working toward the same goals. The student is part of a group identity that strives for excellence, and the code establishes a tradition toward that end. We have selected a Dress and Event Uniform that displays unity and have added elective items to allow for diversity.
- The uniform code should save parents money. The uniform code de-emphasizes the social impact of dress and helps focus the students on character and academic issues. The selected clothes were chosen with price and durability in mind for an overall good value.
- The uniform code addresses security. On field trips, students in uniform aid the teachers in keeping track of everyone. At recess or in the school, teachers and staff can clearly identify students from outsiders.

The administration is responsible for the interpretation of the policy, and the enforcement of the policy is the responsibility of parents, administration, faculty, and staff. Students and parents will be notified of uniform infractions and a habit of non-compliance may result in further discipline. **Students are expected to be in uniform while on campus unless specified otherwise by the administration.** 

# Special Occasions and Accessories

#### **Christmas Program Attire: Girls**

- Festive dresses and skirts. Girls are to exhibit feminine modesty.
- Neckline is no lower than four fingers from the collarbone
- Sleeveless (tank-style) dress top is permitted though no spaghetti straps, backless, or strapless tops, unless worn with a sweater or shrug for evening duration
- Hemline is knee length or longer
- Dress shoes with heels no more than 2 inches

#### **Christmas Program Attire: Boys**

- Long-sleeve dress shirt with a collar
- Dress pants
- Socks to match shoes or pants
- Dress shoes
- Belt to match shoes
- Optional items: sweater, tie, vest, jacket

#### **Protocol Attire**

Students in grades 7-12 will be given specific instructions for what to wear to their spring protocol event.

#### Upper School Drama/Arts Festival/Spring Playhouse Attire

Students should wear either their school uniform or nice clothes that portray appreciation for the hard work put into the evening. In other words, avoid scooting in straight off the baseball field!

#### Field Day, Club, and Team Attire

Students should wear their P.E. uniform if they have one, or if not, another Agape Christi shirt with black bottoms (reaching the tips of the fingers or longer). Team sports may have additional uniform requirements. Non-athletic clubs before or after school should remain in their school uniform, unless given specific instructions to change.

#### **Hair and Accessories**

- Lower School girls (pk-6th grade) may wear one per ear stud earrings and inconspicuous rings (one per hand) and watches that coordinate with the outfit. Toy or character jewelry is not permitted. Make-up is not permitted. Flesh-tone (red, pink, beige, brown, white) shades of nail color are permitted (blue is not a human flesh tone).
- All boys are limited to rings (one per hand) and a watch that coordinates with the outfit. Toy or character jewelry is not permitted. No earrings, make-up, or nail polish. Necklaces must not be visible.
- Upper School young ladies may wear classic simple and discreet jewelry (not trendy). One per ear of earrings (on the lobe, not the cartilage). Use the one-inch rule as a guide: if the earring is larger than one-inch, it isn't discreet
- Upper School young ladies may wear daytime make-up that is subtler and incorporates lighter tones. Flesh-tone
  (red, pink, beige, brown, white) shades of nail color are permitted (blue is not a human flesh tone). Dark, heavy
  eye-makeup is not permitted.
- Hair accessories must be simple and discreet, matching clothing or hair. Scarves and bandanas are not permitted.
- Hair must be neatly combed (e.g. no faux hawks) and trimmed and of a natural hair color. Boys' hair should be
  masculine (not too long) and girls' hair should be feminine (not too short). No facial hair for boys: must be clean
  shaven.
- Only Agape Christi ball caps are allowed for recess and p.e.
- During school events or functions, students may not wear items (e.g., sweatshirts, hats) that promote particular organizations, brands, or concepts that are antithetical to Christian living.

Slacks	<ul> <li>Men's ties are not permitted.</li> <li>Dresses and skirts are encouraged; however, slacks may be worn. Slacks should sit at or above hips and be full length. Jeans, cargo pants, leggings, capris, cords, and sweatpants are not permitted.</li> <li>One should be able to pull pants away from the leg—and not just because the material is stretchy.</li> <li>Panty lines are not visible. ### **Grade 12 Professional Uniform**



In addition to the uniform, seniors have the option of wearing a professional uniform on M, Tu, W, F. We are aiming for a classic, not trendy, appearance. Violations of the uniform code may result in loss of uniform privilege.

Item	Description
Shirt	<ul> <li>Non-flashy button-down dress shirt. The first button under the collar must be buttoned.</li> <li>If needed, subtle cuff-links are worn.</li> <li>If desired, a vest, cardigan or pull-over sweater is worn.</li> <li>Men's ties are permitted, but not required.</li> </ul>
Slacks	<ul> <li>Neutral colored slacks (not jeans, cargo pants, or corduroy) of appropriate fit are worn with shirts tucked in with a black or brown leather belt.</li> <li>One should be able to pull pants away from the leg—and not just because the material is stretchy.</li> </ul>
Footwear	<ul> <li>Socks should match either the pant or shoe color (solid or conservative pattern).</li> <li>Shoes may be black or brown, leather-like and polished as needed.</li> <li>Shoes should be dressy, sturdy, and comfortable. No open-toed or backless shoes. Heels may not be taller than 2 inches. Dress shoes do not need to be a formal dress shoe, such as wingtip patent leather, but sneakers, Vans, Toms, combat boots, and moccasins do not qualify as dress shoes. Boat shoes are acceptable if they are leather. Dress boots may be worn (the tread is a clue to its dressiness).</li> </ul>
Hair, Make-Up, Jewelry	<ul> <li>No facial hair for boys: must be clean shaven.</li> <li>Hair must be neatly combed (e.g., no faux hawks), trimmed (not too long) and of a natural hair color.</li> <li>All boys are limited to rings (one per hand) and a watch that coordinates with the outfit. Toy or character jewelry is not permitted. No earrings, make-up, or nail polish. Necklaces must not be visible.</li> </ul>
